



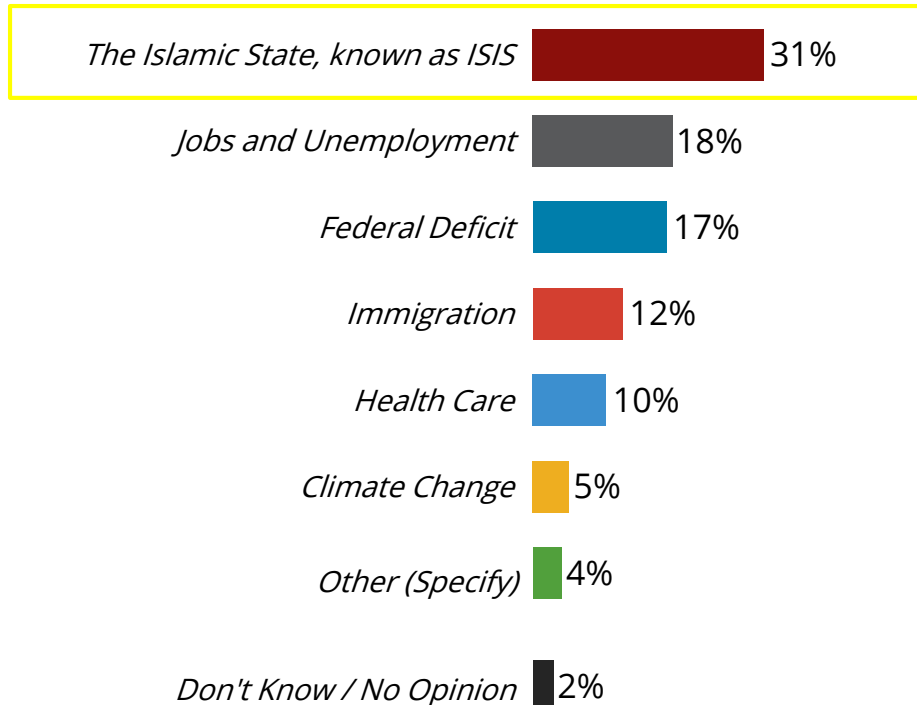

Which of the following do you see as the most important issue facing the country right now?

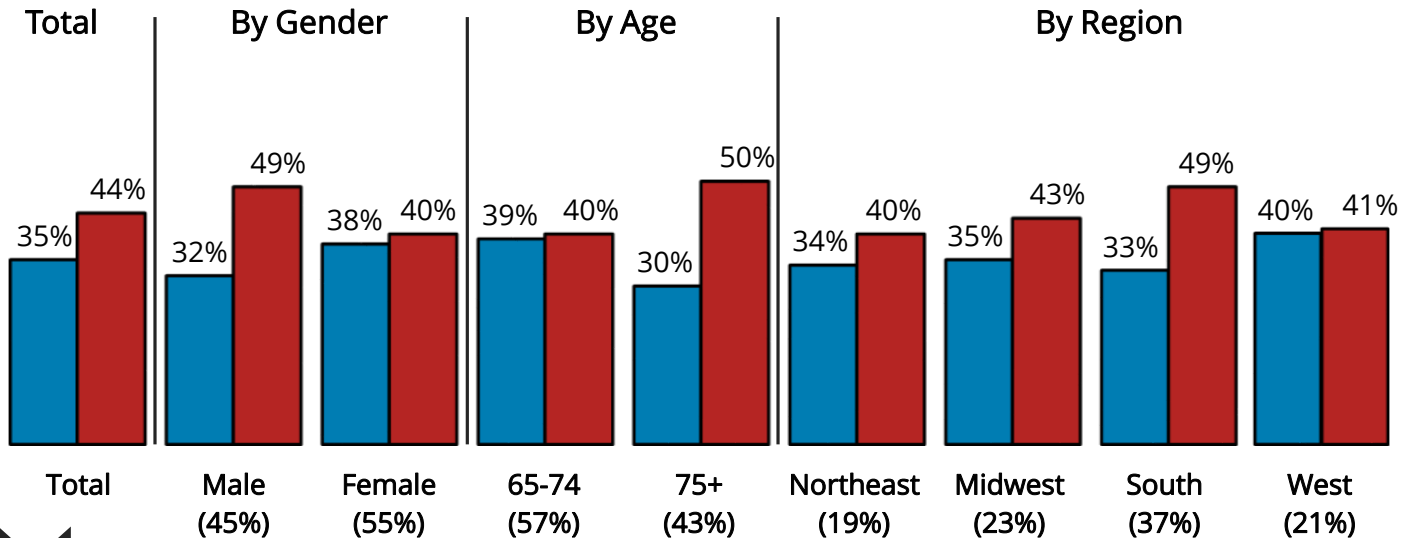


# Seniors favor a Republican Congressional Candidate.

If the 2016 elections for Congress were being held today, would you be more likely to vote for a Democratic or Republican candidate in your Congressional district?

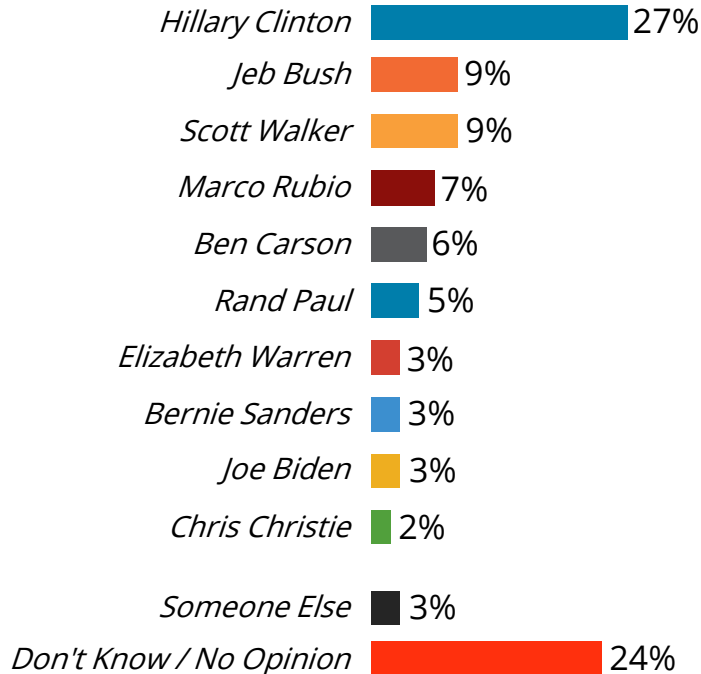

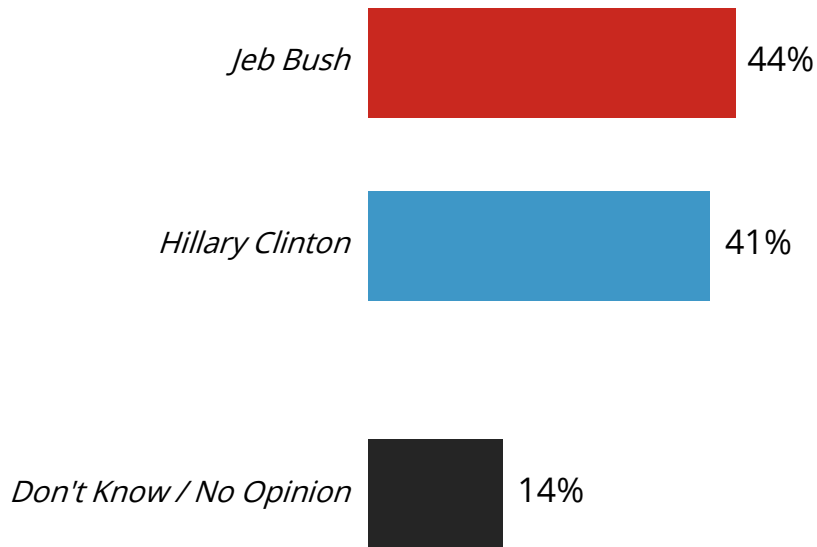
Hillary Clinton stands out among the pack, with more seniors (27%) saying they would vote for her if the 2016 presidential election were held today, than any other candidate in the running.

In a head to head ballot, Bush beats Clinton among seniors.

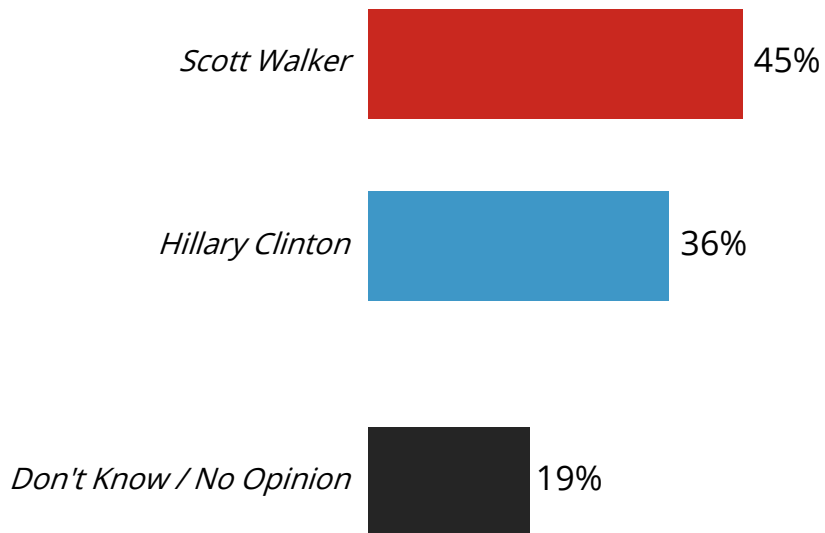

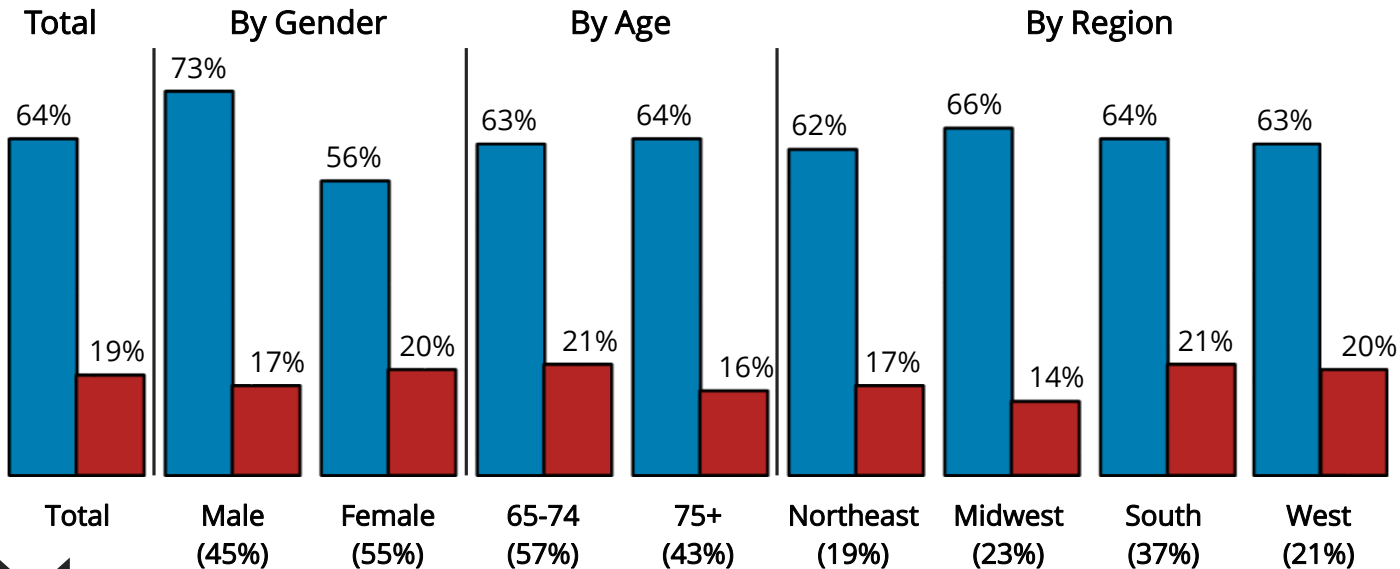

Do you think such an agreement should or should not be voted on by Congress?

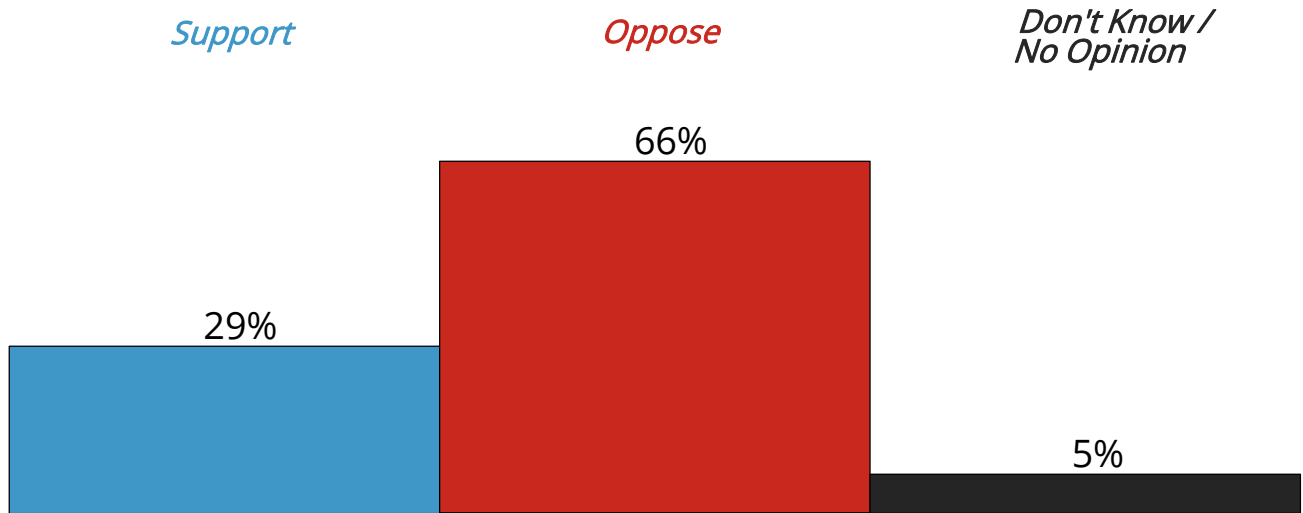

President Obama has taken executive action allowing undocumented immigrants to remain in the United States. Do you support or oppose Obama's executive action?





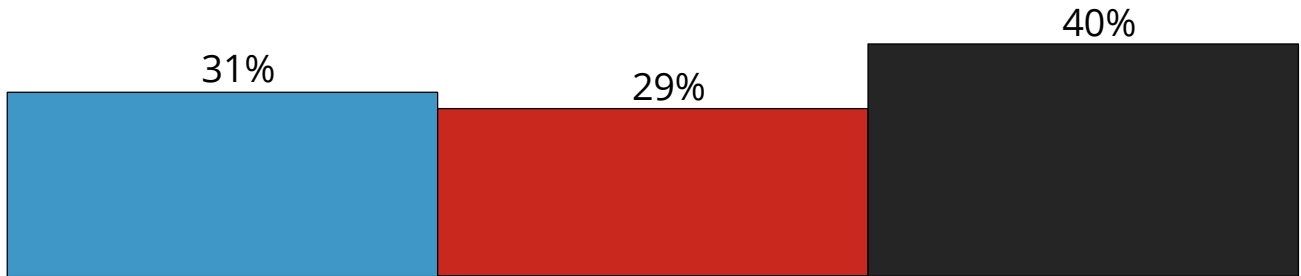
Seniors generally uncertain when asked about their state's job making sure homebound seniors are able to cast votes on Election day.
