



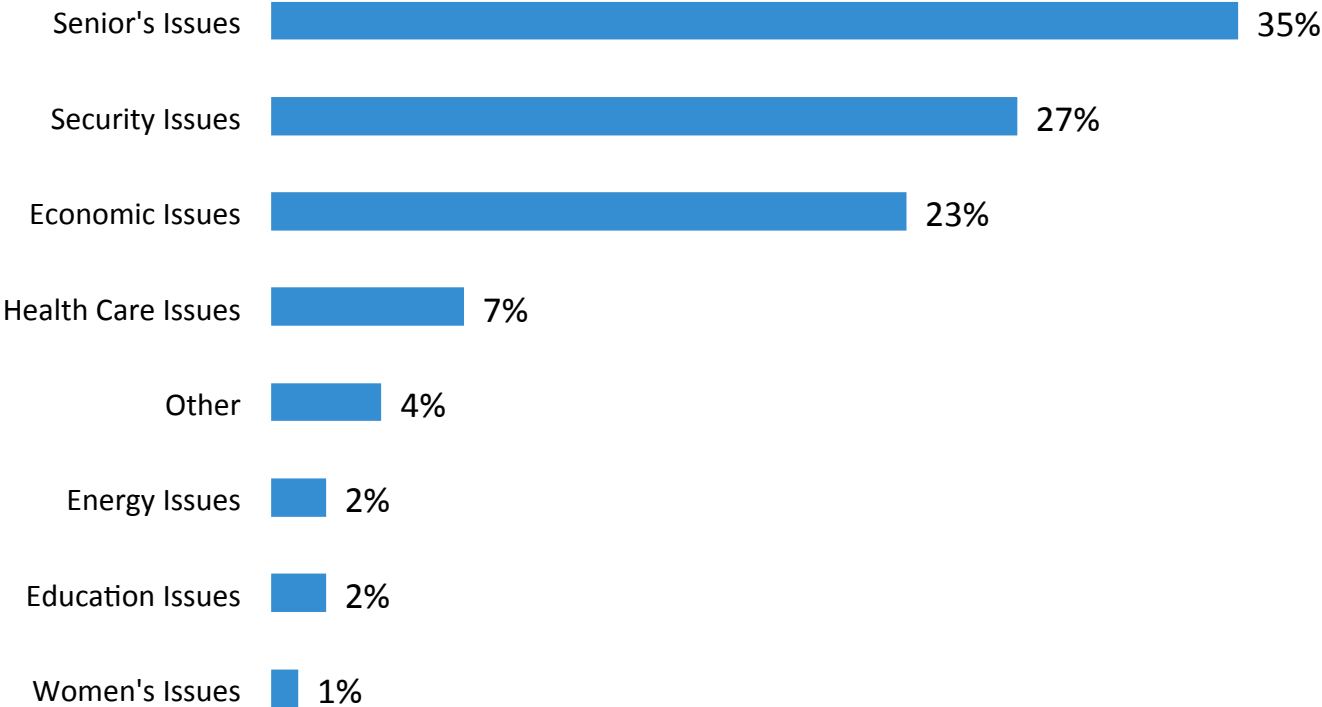

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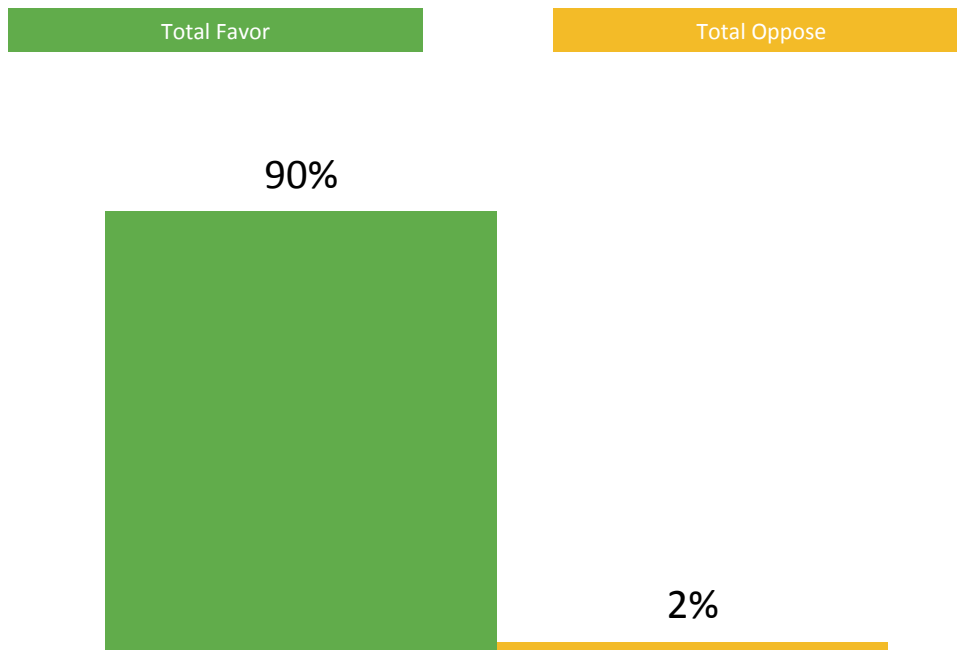

Now, thinking about your vote, what would you say is the top set of issues on your mind when you cast your vote for federal offices such as U.S. Senate or Congress?



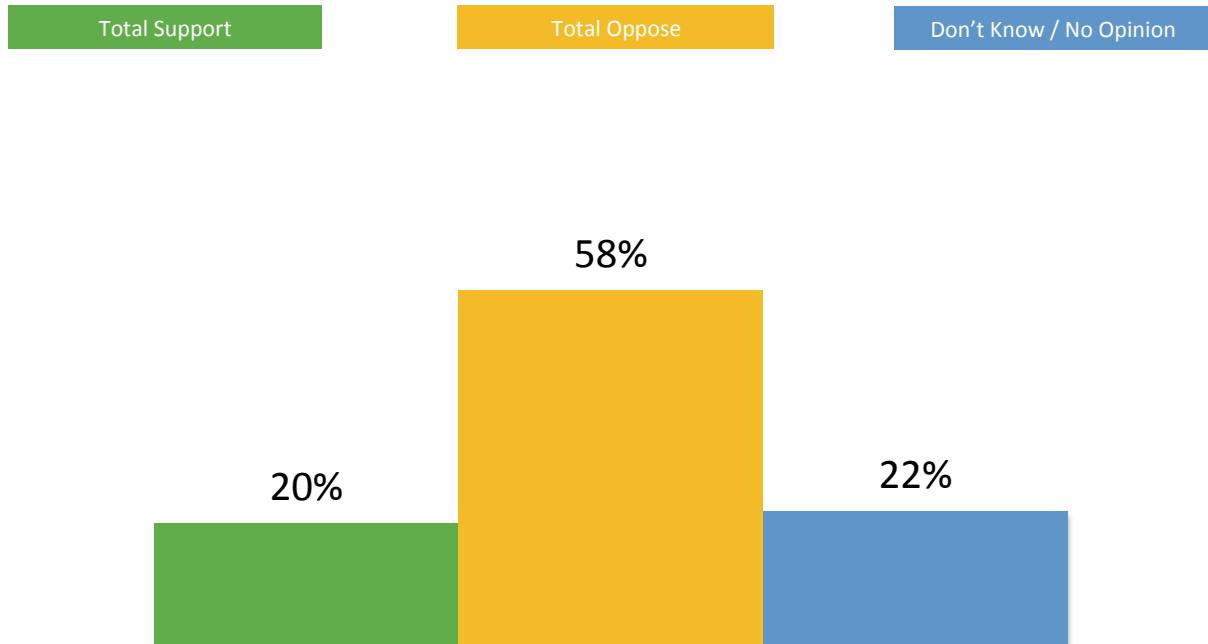
Nine in 10 Seniors (90%) favor Medicare coverage of home healthcare services

Home healthcare services are skilled clinical services provided under a physician's care to homebound seniors and disabled Americans inside their home. Medicare currently covers home healthcare services, which can be delivered at a lower cost to Medicare than facility-based healthcare services. Do you favor or oppose Medicare coverage of these home healthcare services?



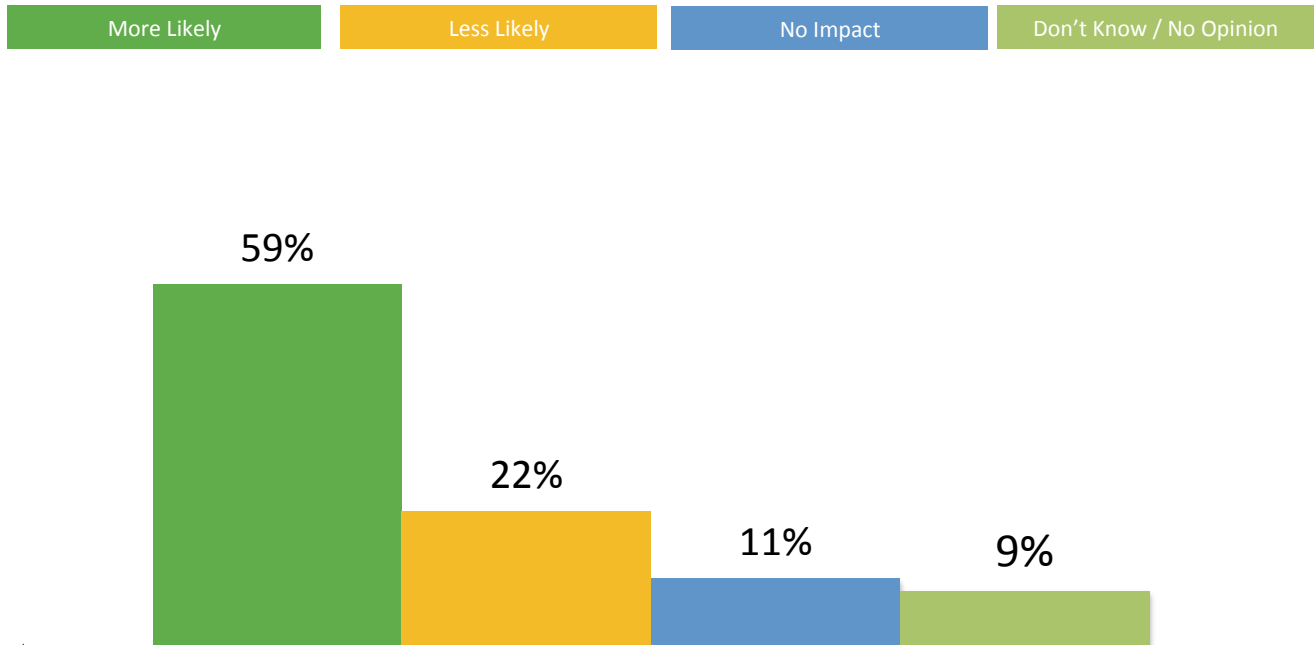
Six in 10 seniors (58%) oppose copayments on home health services

As you may know, the Obama administration is considering introducing health insurance copayments for seniors who use Medicare home healthcare services, also referred to as home health. Do you support or oppose health insurance copayments totaling \$100 each time a Medicare patient is prescribed home health?



Six in 10 seniors (59%) say they are more likely to support a candidate who opposes cuts to home health

Would you be more or less likely to vote for a candidate for president who opposes any cuts in funding to Medicare home health benefits?



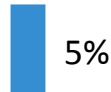
Eight in 10 seniors (80%) say we should support services like home health

Some say Medicare home health services have allowed millions of seniors and disabled Americans to receive the medical treatment they need at home, which costs much less than care delivered hospitals and nursing homes. To keep Medicare spending under control, we should support and use not cut cost-effective services like home health.

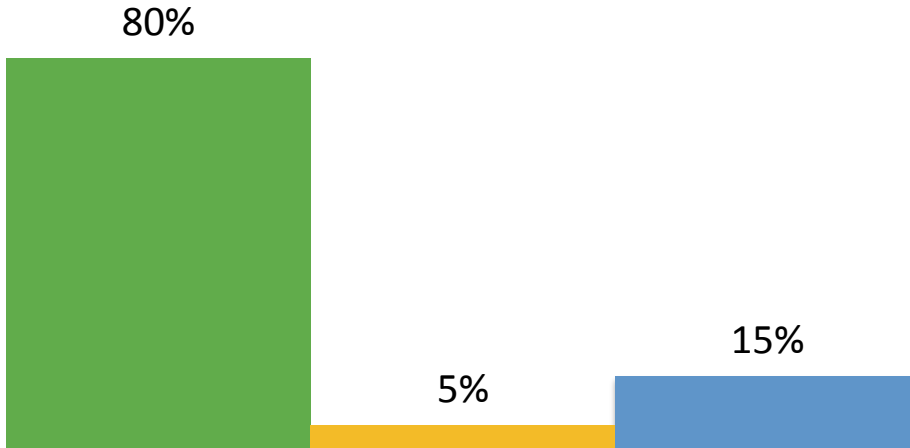
